- 3) **Chardonnay "Clos du Bois"** *California* Dry with hints of white peach 12 / 36
- 4) **Chenin Blanc "Dry Creek"** *California* Pear and watermelon on the palate, a perfect with oysters 12/36
- 5) **Cabernet Sauvignon "Franciscan"** *California* Full bodied, cherry and toasted caramel notes 12/36
- 6) **Pinot Noir "Elouan"** *Oregon* Ripe cherry on the palate, cherry and ripe fruit hints 12/36
- 7) **El Red Malbec** *Mendoza, Argentina* Ripe fruits, dark chocolate and coffee beans on the finish 12/36
- 8) **Cabernet Franc, "Finger Lakes"** *New York* Hints of ripe red and dark fruit 12/36

- 12) **Sancerre, Domaine Fouassier, "Sur Le Fort"** *Sancerre, France* Crisp and refreshing, great seafood wine 20 / 60
- 13) **Chardonnay Montagny 1^{er} Cru Les Coeres** *Bordeaux, France* 100% chardonnay, flinty mineral notes 20/60
- 14) **Chenin Blanc, "Moulin Touchais Coteaux Dulayon"** *France* Rich and vibrant acidity 15 / 45
- 15) **Muscadet, "Domaine Menard Goborit"** *Loire Valley, France* Great with shellfish 15 / 45
- 16) **Cabernet Sauvignon, "Dry Creek"**, *Sonoma County, California* 91 Wine spectator 20 / 60
- 17) **Cabernet Franc, "Le Coup D'douze"** *Loire Valley, France* 100 % Cabernet Franc 15 / 45
- 18) **Red Blend, "Geyserville"**, *Alexander Valley, California* Ripe fruit, soft tannins 15 / 45
- 19) **Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, "Hautes-Cotes de Beaune"** *Burgundy, France* Hints of ripe red pears raspberry notes 15/45

- 22) **Torresella Prosecco DOC Italy** Delicate fruit notes, delicate bubbles and a clean, crisp finish 40
- 23) **J Lohr. Chardonnay "Riverstone Arroyo Seco"** *Monterey, California* Pear, apricot, hazelnut and hints of oak 36
- 24) **Domaine Louis Moreau Chablis** *Burgundy, France* 100 % Chard, floral nose, with hint of apple and pear 60
- 25) **Chateau de Varennes Savennieres Chenin Sec** *France* Seafood and oyster wine 45
- 26) **Frogs Leap, Chardonnay** *Napa Valley* Aromas of wet stone and white peaches 60
- 27) **Oyster Bay, Sauvignon Blanc** *Marlborough, New Zealand* Grapefruit and rich on the palate 36
- 28) **Frogs Leap, Sauvignon Blanc** *Napa Valley* Aromas of lemongrass and citrus 45
- 29) **La Craie Vouvray Chenin Blanc** *Loire Valley, France* A dry white with hints of pears, apples and quince 45
- 30) **La Cana, Albarino** *Spain* Fruit flavors of poached apricots and tangerines, 91 WS 45

- 33) **Josh Cabernet Sauvignon** *Paso Robles, California* Full-bodied, complex flavors of hazelnut and blackberries 36
- 34) **J Lohr Hilltop Cabernet Sauvignon** *Paso Robles, California* Dark in color, dense and soft on the palate 45
- 35) **Frogs Leap, Cabernet Sauvignon** *Napa Valley, California* Hints of stewed plums and cedar 75
- 36) **Quilt Cabernet Sauvignon** *Napa Valley, California* Know for its rich complex profile with hints of Blackberry and cassis 45
- 37) **Typesetter Cabernet Sauvignon** *Napa Valley, California* Hints of coffee, tobacco and finishes with soft tannins 45
- 38) **Frogs Leap Merlot** *Napa Valley, California* Notes of plums, black cherry and sage 65
- 39) **Trefethen Dragon's Tooth Red Blend** *Napa Valley, California* 40% Malbec, 32% Petit Verdot, 5% Merlot, 32% Cabernet 75
- 40) **La Crema, Pinot Noir** *Sonoma, California* Medium body with flavors of red cherry and plums 40
- 41) **J Lohr, "Fogs Reach", Pinot Noir** *Sonoma, California* Bing cherry and strawberry candy aromas 65
- 42) **Sean Minor Pinot Noir** *California* Velvety texture, soft, silky tannins, bright acidity, and a long, smooth finish 45
- 43) **Prisoner "Saldo" Zinfandel** *California* Blend of Zinfandel, Petite Syrah and Syrah grapes 45
- 44) **Dry Creek Zinfandel** *California* Full-bodied, fruit-forward with bright acidity and brambly fruit notes 45
- 45) **Cuentavina 2021 Garnacha** *Rioja, Spain* 100 % Garnacha (95 pts *Jeb Dunnuck*) 75
- 46) **Torre Muga** *Rioja, Spain* 75% tempranillo, 15 % Mazuelo, 10 % Graciano grapes 60
- 47) **Castello di Bossi "Chianti" Classico"** *Italy* Earthy flavors joined with black Cherries on the finish 36
- 48) **Penfold Max's Shiraz** *Australia* Soft tannins, jammy fruit with notes of Licorice, anise and earthy leather 40
- 49) **L'Altra Barbera D'Asti** *Italy* Full-bodied, well balanced and dry wine. The finish is long, with notes of fruit 40
- 50) **Chateau La Tour de Mons Margaux** *France* Deep color, aromatic profile of redcurrants, kirsch, tobacco, and cedar 50
- 51) **The Prisoner 2021 Red Blend** *Napa Valley, California* Red Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Petit Syrah blend 75
